2.	In item 16.3 "Technical capacity of	The Contracting authority could not provide

tenderer" from the Selection and Award Criteria of the Supply Contract Notice for Lot 1, Lot 2 and Lot 3 is stated: "the tenderer has delivered supplies under at least 1 contract with budget ...... In fields related to this contract (supply of specialized fire equipment and/or specialized vehicles)...... ". Please confirm that the building and supply of 4 pcs of specialized mobile systems for video surveillance equipped with cooled thermal imaging cameras, day cameras, LRF, etc. for surveillance of the state border with the aim of detection of illegal activities and immigrants as well as smuggling falls within the defined scope for similar experience, i.e. "supply of specialized vehicles"

information on the eligibility of the tenderers in advance. Determining the eligibility of the tenderers falls into the competences of the Evaluation committee for assessment of offers which will be established in relation to the above tender procedure.

 In art. 3.4. from the Instructions to tenderers is requested the tenderers to provide declarations that they are not in any of the exclusion situations listed in Section 2.3.4 of the Practical Guide.

Please advise whether separate declaration with regard to the exclusion situations set in Section 2.3.4 of the Practical Guide shall be provided or the provision of the Declaration on honour on exclusion criteria and selection criteria shall be deemed enough.

According to p. 2.3.3.3. "Evidence to be provided" of the PRAG, candidates, tenderers and applicants must sign a declaration together with their applications, certifying that they do not fall into any of the exclusion situations cited under sections 2.3.3.1 and 2.3.3.2 and, where applicable, that it has taken adequate measures to remedy the situation. With regards to the above, the provision of a Declaration on honour on exclusion criteria and selection criteria, being part of the tender dossier, is adequate to meet the tender requirements.

3. In item 18 from Annex II+III: Technical Specifications + Technical Offer for Lot 1 "Supply of specialized vehicles for forest fires extinquishing" is stated:

Exit pupil relief – 8 mm;

Exit pupil relief – 17 mm.

Please advise what is the correct value of the exit pupil relief?

On the Contracting Authorities' website and Programmes websites has been published a Corrigendum No 1, as follows:

Instead of: "Exit pupil relief – 17 mm" Read: "Eye pupil relief – 17 mm"

4. In item 18 from Lot 1 "Supply of specialized vehicles for forest fire extinguishing" and item 18 – Lot 2 "Supply of special vehicles for forest fires" as well as in item 17 from Lot 3 "Supply of specialized vehicle for rapid interventions – pick up" from Annex II+III: Technical Specifications + Technical Offer is stated: Range of protection (IP) – IP 68 according to BDS EN 60529 or equivalent.

According to the Minimal technical requirements, set out in the tender dossier, the Range of protection (IP), refered to in item 18 from Lot 1 "Supply of specialized vehicles for forest fire extinguishing" and item 18 – Lot 2 "Supply of special vehicles for forest fires" as well as in item 17 from Lot 3 "Supply of specialized vehicle for rapid interventions – pick up" from Annex II+III: Technical Specifications + Technical Offer, is IP 68 according to BDS EN 60529 or equivalent.

Taking into consideration the fact that as per the IP Rating Chart – IP68 is extremely high degree of protection, i.e. protection from long term immersion (beyond 1 m) up to a specified pressure and the fact that most of the night vision devices on the market have degree of protection equal to IP66 or IP67, except for specific devices (in most of the cases night vision monoculars that are intended for diving) we would like to ask the Contracting Authority to consider the possibility to change this requirement in accordance with the applicable for night vision devices degree of protection.

Could you please confirm that there is a technical mistake and the requirement for pitch size must be read as "25  $\mu m$  or better"
